II. LITURGI FIRMAN

1. BACAAN PERTAMA | Kejadian 2:7–9; 3:1–7

Ketika Tuhan Allah menjadikan langit dan bumi, Ia membentuk manusia dari debu tanah dan menghembuskan nafas hidup ke dalam hidungnya. Demikianlah manusia itu menjadi makhluk yang hidup. Selanjutnya Tuhan Allah membuat taman di Eden, di sebelah timur; disitulah ditempatkan-Nya manusia yang dibentuk-Nya itu. Lalu Tuhan Allah menumbuhkan berbagai pohon dari bumi, yang menarik dan yang baik untuk dimakan buahnya; di tengah-tengah taman itu Ia menumbuhkan pohon kehidupan, serta pohon pengetahuan tentang yang baik dan yang jahat.

Dari segala binatang di darat yang dijadikan oleh Tuhan Allah ular adalah binatang yang paling cerdik. Ular itu berkata kepada perempuan yang telah diciptakan Tuhan, "Tentulah Allah berfirman: Semua pohon dalam taman ini jangan kamu makan buahnya, bukan?" Sahut perempuan itu kepada ular, "Buah pohon-pohon dalam taman ini boleh kami makan. Tetapi tentang buah pohon yang ada di tengah taman, Allah berfirman: Jangan kamu makan ataupun kamu raba buah itu, nanti kamu mati."

Tetapi ular itu berkata kepada perempuan itu, "Sekali-kali kamu tidak akan mati! Tetapi Allah mengetahui, bahwa pada waktu kamu memakannya matamu akan terbuka, dan kamu akan menjadi seperti Allah, tahu tentang yang baik dan yang jahat." Perempuan itu melihat, bahwa buah pohon itu baik untuk dimakan, dan sedap kelihatannya, lagipula pohon itu menarik hati karena memberi pengertian. Maka ia mengambil dari buahnya, lalu dimakan, dan diberikannya juga kepada suaminya yang bersama-sama dengan dia; dan suaminya pun memakannya. Maka terbukalah mata mereka berdua, dan mereka tahu, bahwa mereka telanjang; lalu mereka menyemat daun pohon ara dan membuat cawat.

3. BACAAN KEDUA | Romans 5:12, 17–19

Saudara-saudara, dosa telah masuk ke dalam dunia lantaran satu orang, dan karena dosa itu, masuklah juga maut. Demikianlah maut telah menjalar kepada semua orang, karena semua orang telah berbuat dosa. Tetapi, jika oleh dosa satu orang maut telah berkuasa, lebih benarlah yang terjadi atas mereka yang telah menerima kelimpahan kasih karunia dan anugerah kebenaran; mereka akan hidup dan berkuasa oleh karena satu orang itu, yaitu Yesus Kristus.

Sebab itu, seperti oleh satu pelanggaran semua orang beroleh penghukuman, demikian pula oleh satu perbuatan kebenaran semua orang beroleh pembenaran untuk hidup. Jadi seperti oleh ketidaktaatan satu orang semua orang telah menjadi orang berdosa, demikian pula oleh ketaatan satu orang semua orang menjadi orang benar.

4. INJIL | Matthew 4:1–11

Sekali peristiwa Yesus dibawa oleh Roh ke padang gurun supaya dicobai Iblis. Setelah berpuasa empat puluh hari dan empat puluh malam, akhirnya laparlah Yesus. Lalu datanglah si pencoba itu dan berkata kepada-Nya, "Jika Engkau Anak Allah, perintahkanlah supaya batu-batu ini menjadi roti." Tetapi Yesus menjawab, "Ada tertulis: Manusia hidup bukan dari roti saja, tetapi dari setiap firman yang keluar dari mulut Allah."

Kemudian Iblis membawa Yesus ke Kota Suci dan menempatkan Dia di bubungan Bait Allah. Lalu Iblis berkata kepada-Nya, "Jika Engkau Anak Allah, jatuhkanlah diri-Mu ke bawah, sebab ada tertulis: Mengenai Engkau Ia akan memerintahkan malaikat-malaikat-Nya, dan mereka akan menatang Engkau di atas tangannya, supaya kaki-Mu jangan terantuk kepada batu." Yesus berkata kepadanya, "Ada pula tertulis: Janganlah engkau mencobai Tuhan, Allahmu!" Lalu Iblis membawa Yesus ke atas gunung yang sangat tinggi dan memperlihatkan kepada-Nya semua kerajaan dunia dengan kemegahannya. Iblis berkata kepada-Nya, "Semua itu akan kuberikan kepada-Mu, jika Engkau sujud menyembah aku." Maka berkatalah Yesus kepadanya, "Enyahlah, Iblis! Sebab ada tertulis: Engkau harus menyembah Tuhan, Allahmu, dan hanya kepada Dia sajalah engkau berbakti!" Lalu Iblis meninggalkan Yesus, dan lihatlah, malaikat-malaikat datang melayani Dia.


APA ITU MASA PRAPASKAH?

Masa 40 hari yang dimulai dari Rabu Abu, 18 Februari hingga awal Triduum Paskah pada Misa Perjamuan Tuhan pada Kamis Putih, 2 April.

DOA — PUASA - SEDEKAH



APA ITU PUASA?



Satu kali makan sehari, dan dua kali makan yang lebih kecil yang jika dijumlahkan tidak akan melebihi satu kali makan lengkap. Hanya air dan obat-obatan yang diperbolehkan di antara waktu makan pada hari-hari puasa.

Umat Katolik berusia 18-59 tahun wajib berpuasa pada Rabu Abu dan Jumat Agung.

PANTANG MAKAN DAGING



Pantang makan berarti menahan diri dari mengonsumsi daging seperti daging sapi, daging sapi muda, daging babi, atau unggas. Telur dan produk susu diperbolehkan. Ikan dan kerang boleh dikonsumsi.

Umat Katolik berusia 14 tahun ke atas harus berpantang makan daging pada Rabu Abu, semua hari Jumat selama masa Prapaskah, dan Jumat Agung.

PENGECEUALIAN



Berdasarkan Hukum Kanonik, pengecualian diberikan kepada orang sakit, orang lanjut usia, ibu hamil atau menyusui, dan pekerja kasar yang kesehatan atau pekerjaannya membutuhkan daging atau makanan tambahan.

TATA CARA PRAPASKAH


Selama Prapaskah, kita dianjurkan untuk menghadiri Misa harian, menerima Komuni Kudus, mengikuti ibadah penitensi, dan menerima pengampunan sakramental.

Ibadah Penitensi akan tersedia di St. Philip Benizi pada Senin, Rabu & Sabtu setelah Misa pukul 08.30 dan Selasa & Kamis setelah Misa 18.30



Pada tanggal 8 Februari 2026, suasana dipenuhi tawa dan cerita nostalgia saat KKIOC menyelenggarakan Pertemuan Tahunan Lansia. Acara yang berharga ini menyatukan komunitas lansia Indonesia yang dinamis yang tinggal di Amerika Serikat, membina lingkungan inklusivitas, iman, dan persahabatan.


WHAT IS FASTING?



One meal a day, and two smaller meals which, if added together, would not exceed a full meal. Only water and medicine is permitted between meals on fast days.

Catholics ages 18 - 59 are obliged to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

ABSTINENCE FROM MEAT



Abstinence means refraining from eating meat such as beef, veal, pork, or poultry. Eggs and dairy products are permitted. Fish and shellfish may be consumed.

Catholics aged 14 and older are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays of Lent and Good Friday.

EXCEPTIONS



Under Canon Law, exemptions are granted to the sick, the elderly, pregnant or nursing mothers, and manual laborers whose health or work requires meat or additional sustenance.


LENTEN PRACTICES

Our Indonesian Catholic Journey in America

Allow us to remember the origins of KKIOC—before KKIOC, there was **KKIA (Keluarga Katolik Indonesia di Amerika)**. KKIA (Indonesian Catholic Family in America) was the predecessor of various KKI- groups in Southern California (i.e. ICADLA, KKIOC, ICCDSB & KKI-SD). The organization was founded on February 19, 1984 in Van Nuys, at the home of Ronnie & Edwina Oey. Previously, if an Indonesian priest happened to stop by Los Angeles, Catholic residents would gather for the rosary prayer at various homes.

Understandably, many of our members faced language barriers in attending Mass and other activities at local churches. Upon the suggestion of two priests, Pastor William van Gastel from Spokane & Pastor Doehne OSC from Bandung, a community organization for the Catholic faithful in Southern California was formed. The first chairman was John Hartanto, followed by Josef Oei, Francisca Busono, Paul Wiharja, and Lepie Pranata.

Quoting former chairwoman Francisca Busono in the commemorative book, **One Decade of KKIA**: “KKIA is a platform for all Indonesian Catholic faithful and sympathizers to assist the local church in enhancing the appreciation of faith, fostering friendship and a spirit of mutual help among the Indonesian community in America by holding various activities such as Christmas Mass, Easter, retreats, recollections, rosary prayers, Way of the Cross, and prayer fellowships in Indonesian.”

Our prayers to get a permanent shepherd to serve the congregation were finally answered with the arrival of Fr. Istejamaya Pr in August 1991. Then in August 15, 1993, we even got 2 Fathers: Fr. Raymundus Bhia Wea, SVD & Fr. Lukas Bao Teluma, SVD. Other priests followed with Fr. Linus Tiala, Fr. Josef Dowa Pr, Fr. Heru Haryanto Pr, Fr. Gotlief Sianpar O Carm, Fr. Tulus Sudiarta Pr, and finally one of our own members' sons became a priest: Fr. Budi Wardhana. Also, Philip Hardjadinata became a Deacon.

Mrs. Helen Ziashari and Dr. Tony Tan were active in fundraising. We once held a Mazda car lottery, Garuda airline tickets, and an Easter Bazaar, etc. In 1991, thanks to the efforts of Mr. Otto Boyoh, KKIA was registered in Sacramento as a non-profit as a religious corporation domiciled in and around Los Angeles.

Our Indonesian Catholic Journey in America

When KKIA was founded in 1984, we did not fully understand how to organize and were not under the auspices of the diocese. Before the formation of KKIOC, KKIA was paying \$40,000 in operating cost per year to pay for the priests' living expenses, car insurance, and health insurance of our Fathers. It was only after being invited to San Francisco for the eighth anniversary of [WKICU](#) that our eyes were opened; it was more beneficial to join a diocese than to struggle to finance everything ourselves.

After the Plenary meeting, Lepie Pranata decided to bring KKIA under the protection of the Diocese, becoming [IC-ADLA](#), [KKIOC](#), [ICC-DSB](#) & [KKI-SD](#).







Children's Liturgy of the Word

Parents: We invite you to spend some time discussing this weekend's readings with your children. By helping them understand God's word, you will help build a strong foundation of faith!

First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7 (The First Mistake)

The Story: In the very beginning, God made a beautiful garden for Adam and Eve. He gave them everything they needed, but he told them not to eat from one specific tree in the middle of the garden. One day, a sneaky snake told Eve a lie. He said that if she ate the fruit, she would be just like God! Eve believed the snake and ate the fruit, and Adam did too.

The Lesson: This story teaches us that sometimes we are tempted to do things we know are wrong. Adam and Eve didn't listen to God, and that was the first time sin entered the world.

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19 (The Great Helper)

The Message: St. Paul explains that even though Adam made a mistake that brought sadness into the world, Jesus brought a much bigger "free gift."

The Lesson: Because Jesus is so good and always listened to God, He helps fix the mistakes of the whole world. He is like a superhero who helps us stay on the right path!

Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11 (Jesus in the Desert)

The Story: After Jesus was baptized, he went into the desert for 40 days to pray and be alone with God. He didn't eat anything, so he was very, very hungry. The devil came and tried to trick Jesus three times:

1. **The Food Trick:** The devil said, "If you're God's son, turn these stones into bread!" Jesus said, "We need God's Word even more than we need bread."
2. **The Show-Off Trick:** The devil told Jesus to jump off a tall building to prove God would save him. Jesus said, "Don't test God."
3. **The Power Trick:** The devil offered Jesus all the kingdoms of the world if Jesus would just bow down to him. Jesus said, "Go away! We only worship and serve God."

The Lesson: Jesus showed us that even when things are hard or we are tempted to be selfish, we can use God's words in the Bible to help us say "no" to what is wrong.




