KKIOC Galang Dukungan Terhadap Studi Lanjutan Romo Yusuf Widiarko

Jemaat Keluarga Katolik Indonesia Orange County (KKIOC) berhasil menyelesaikan upaya penggalangan dana, mengumpulkan total \$2.600 untuk mendukung pendidikan lanjutan Pastor Yusuf Widiarko dari Keuskupan Purwokerto di Indonesia.

Pastor Yusuf Widiarko sedang menempuh studi Psikologi lanjutan di Roma, yang akan membekalinya untuk pelayanan yang lebih luas, tidak hanya kepada jemaat tetapi juga kepada para imam, biarawan, biarawati, dan seminaris. Pendidikannya sebelumnya tertunda karena kendala keuangan, tetapi dengan pendanaan untuk tahun pertama yang telah terjamin, kampanye KKIOC baru-baru ini berfokus pada penggalangan dana yang dibutuhkan untuk tahun kedua studinya.

Penggalangan dana tersebut berlangsung selama kunjungan Pastor Antonius Galih Arga Wiwin Aryanto, Pr., M.A., S.T.D. dari Keuskupan Purwokerto ke California Selatan, dan didukung secara signifikan oleh komunitas KKIOC, termasuk diintegrasikan dengan acara Doa Rosario KKIOC yang diadakan pada tanggal 3 Januari 2026.

Pastor Galih menyampaikan terima kasih yang tulus kepada jemaat KKIOC atas kemurahan hati mereka dan mengkonfirmasi bahwa dana sebesar \$2.600 yang terkumpul telah berhasil ditransfer ke Keuskupan Purwokerto. Ucapan terima kasih khusus juga diberikan kepada Helen Ziashari atas dedikasinya dalam mengorganisir penggalangan dana dan memfasilitasi transfer dana ke Indonesia. Upaya kolektif ini menunjukkan komitmen KKIOC kepada komunitas iman dan misi Gereja yang lebih luas.

RD. YUSUF WIDIARKO

Rm. Yusuf Widiarko (35 tahun) adalah seorang imam diosesan Keuskupan Purwokerto. Ia ditahbiskan sebagai imam pada 31 Juli 2018, dan kemudian berkarya di Paroki Katedral Kristus Raja Purwokerto (2018-2021), Seminari Tahun Orientasi Rohani St. Agustinus Tegal (2021-2024), dan Paroki St. Petrus Pekalongan (2024-2025).

Perutusan Studi

Sejak 16 Agustus 2025, Rm. Yusuf menjalani perutusan studi S2 di Roma. Ia tinggal di Collegio Internazionale Maria Mater Ecclesiae dan kuliah di Institut Psikologi Universitas Gregoriana Roma.

Rm. Yusuf belajar psikologi hidup rohani. Studinya ini berlangsung selama 4 tahun (2025-2029): prepedeutik/persiapan (1 th), licensiat/S2 (2 th), dan praktek untuk lisensi psikolog (1 th).

Dengan pendekatan interdisipliner (filsafat, teologi, dan psikologi), ilmu dan pengalaman dari studi ini sangat relevan untuk pendampingan panggilan kaum religius dan pendampingan iman umat secara umum. Studi ini diharapkan juga bisa menjawab salah satu tantangan aktual yang dihadapi Gereja dan dunia saat ini, yaitu isu kesehatan mental dan spiritual.



Menyinari Kegelapan: Hari Doa dan Kesadaran Internasional Melawan Perdagangan Manusia

Pada tanggal **8 Februari**, dunia berhenti sejenak untuk memperingati Hari Doa dan Kesadaran Internasional Melawan Perdagangan Manusia. Ini adalah hari yang didedikasikan untuk merefleksikan salah satu krisis paling persisten di zaman kita—sebuah "kejahatan terhadap kemanusiaan" yang berdampak pada jutaan orang secara global. Pemilihan tanggal khusus ini sangat simbolis, karena menandai hari pesta Santa Josephine Bakhita, santo pelindung bagi para penyintas perbudakan modern dan perdagangan manusia.

Warisan Santa Josephine Bakhita

Lahir di Sudan pada tahun 1869, Josephine Bakhita diculik dan dijual sebagai budak pada usia tujuh tahun. Ia mengalami penderitaan yang tak terbayangkan selama bertahun-tahun, menanggung bekas luka fisik dan emosional dari penawanan tersebut. Akhirnya, perjalanannya membawanya ke Italia, di mana ia menemukan kebebasannya dan membaktikan hidupnya untuk pelayanan dan iman.

Kisah hidupnya bukan sekadar tentang penderitaan sejarah, melainkan sebuah mercusuar harapan. Ia mewakili ketangguhan semangat manusia dan kemungkinan pemulihan setelah trauma yang mendalam. Dengan memusatkan hari kesadaran ini pada hari pestanya, kita menghormati martabat setiap individu yang saat ini terjebak dalam eksploitasi.

Realitas Perbudakan Modern

Perdagangan manusia bukanlah peninggalan masa lalu; ini adalah industri ilegal bernilai miliaran dolar yang terus berkembang. Praktik ini tumbuh subur di atas kerentanan, sering kali menyasar mereka yang terasingkan oleh perang, kemiskinan, atau perubahan iklim.

Eksplorasi Tenaga Kerja: Jutaan orang dipaksa bekerja di sektor pertanian, konstruksi, dan manufaktur di bawah ancaman kekerasan.

Perdagangan Seks: Perempuan, laki-laki, dan anak-anak dipaksa masuk ke dalam perdagangan seks komersial melalui penipuan atau kekerasan.

Perekutan Online: Di era digital ini, para pelaku semakin banyak menggunakan media sosial dan penipuan "kerja dari rumah" untuk memikat korban.

Mengapa Doa dan Kesadaran itu Penting?

Meskipun tindakan legislatif dan penegakan hukum sangat penting, Hari Doa Internasional ini menekankan pendekatan holistik:

Memecah Keheningan: Perdagangan manusia berkembang pesat dalam bayang-bayang. Kampanye kesadaran mengedukasi masyarakat tentang cara mengenali tanda-tanda eksploitasi.

Solidaritas Spiritual: Bagi banyak orang, doa adalah cara untuk berdiri dalam solidaritas bersama mereka yang suaranya telah dibungkam, memohon kekuatan bagi para penyintas dan pertobatan bagi para pengeksploitasi.

Advokasi Kebijakan: Hari ini berfungsi sebagai panggilan aksi bagi pemerintah untuk memperkuat undang-undang perlindungan korban dan mengadili mereka yang mengambil keuntungan dari kesengsaraan manusia.

Bagaimana Anda Bisa Membuat Perubahan

Anda tidak perlu menjadi ahli untuk berkontribusi dalam perjuangan melawan perdagangan manusia. Tindakan kecil dapat menghasilkan perubahan besar:

Edukasi Diri Sendiri: Pelajari tanda-tanda peringatan perdagangan manusia, seperti ruang gerak yang dibatasi, tanda-tanda kekerasan fisik, atau ketiadaan dokumen identitas pribadi.

Dukung Merek yang Etis: Teliti rantai pasokan produk yang Anda beli untuk memastikan produk tersebut bebas dari kerja paksa.

Berani Bersuara: Gunakan platform Anda untuk berbagi kisah harapan dan sumber daya bantuan.

"Tuhan menciptakan semua manusia setara dalam hak, kewajiban, dan martabat, dan memanggil mereka untuk hidup bersama sebagai saudara dan saudari." — Paus Fransiskus

KKIOC Rallies Support for Father Yusuf Widiarko's Advanced Studies

The Keluarga Katolik Indonesia Orange County (KKIOC) congregation successfully completed a fundraising effort, collecting a total of \$2,600 to support the continuing education of Father Yusuf Widiarko from the Purwokerto Diocese in Indonesia.

Father Yusuf Widiarko is pursuing advanced Psychology studies in Rome, which will equip him for a broader ministry to not only the congregation but also to priests, brothers, sisters, and seminary students. His education was previously delayed due to financial constraints, but with the funding for the first year secured, the recent KKIOC campaign focused on raising the necessary funds for his second year of study.

The fundraising took place during the visit of Father Antonius Galih Arga Wiwin Aryanto, Pr., M.A., S.T.D. from the Purwokerto Diocese to Southern California, and it was significantly supported by the KKIOC community, including being integrated with the KKIOC Rosary event held on January 3, 2026.

Father Galih extended his heartfelt thanks to the KKIOC congregation for their generosity and confirmed that the collected \$2,600 has been successfully transferred to the Purwokerto Diocese. Special gratitude was also given to Helen Ziashari for her dedication in organizing the fundraising and facilitating the transfer of the funds to Indonesia. This collective effort demonstrates KKIOC's commitment to the faith community and the broader mission of the Church.

RD. YUSUF WIDIARKO

Father Yusuf Widiarko (35 years old) is a diocesan priest of the Diocese of Purwokerto. He was ordained a priest on July 31, 2018, and subsequently served in the Christ the King Cathedral Parish of Purwokerto (2018-2021), St. Augustine Spiritual Orientation Year Seminary in Tegal (2021-2024), and St. Peter Parish in Pekalongan (2024-2025).

Perutusan Studi

Since August 16, 2025, Father Yusuf has been undertaking postgraduate studies in Rome. He lives at the Collegio Internazionale Maria Mater Ecclesiae and studies at the Institute of Psychology of the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. Father Yusuf is studying the psychology of spiritual life. His studies will last for four years (2025-2029): preparatory year (1 year), licentiate / Master's degree (2 years), and practical training for a psychologist's license (1 year).

With an interdisciplinary approach (philosophy, theology, and psychology), the knowledge and experience gained from this study are highly relevant for guiding religious vocations and providing faith-based support to the faithful in general. This study is also expected to address one of the current challenges facing the Church and the world today, namely the issue of mental and spiritual health.





Shining a Light in the Dark: International Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking

On February 8, the world pauses to observe the **International Day of Prayer and Awareness Against Human Trafficking**. It is a day dedicated to reflecting on one of the most persistent crises of our time—a "crime against humanity" that affects millions globally.

The choice of this specific date is deeply symbolic, as it marks the **feast day of St. Josephine Bakhita**, the patron saint of modern-day slavery and human trafficking survivors.

The Legacy of St. Josephine Bakhita

Parents: We invite you to spend some time discussing this weekend's readings with your children. By helping them understand God's word, you will help build a strong foundation of faith!


 **The Busy Day of Jesus.** Jesus spent His whole day traveling and helping as many people as He could.

- **Helping a Friend's Family:** Jesus went to the house of His friends, Peter and Andrew. Peter's mother-in-law was very sick in bed with a high fever. Jesus didn't just stand there; He went to her, took her hand, and helped her up. Immediately, her fever went away! She felt so good that she got up right away to fix them all a snack.
- **Healing at Sunset:** Word got out that Jesus could make people better. By the time the sun went down, the whole town was at the front door! Jesus stayed up late helping everyone who was sick or sad.
- **A Quiet Moment with God:** Even though He was very tired, Jesus woke up very early the next morning while it was still dark. He went to a quiet place all by Himself to pray and talk to God the Father. This gave Him the "superpower" strength to keep helping more people in other towns.

☀️ The Main Theme: "The Helping Hand"

The big lesson for children today is that Jesus cares when we hurt, and He wants us to be helpers too.

- **Jesus Holds Our Hand:** When we have a "boo-boo," feel sick, or are just sad, Jesus is right there with us. Just like He took the lady's hand to help her up, He is always ready to help us feel better.
- **Healed to Help:** As soon as the woman felt better, she started helping others. When we feel happy and healthy, it's our turn to find ways to be "little helpers" at home!
- **The Power of Prayer:** Even Jesus needed a "quiet time" to talk to God. We can talk to God anytime—especially when we feel busy or tired—to fill our hearts back up with love.
