3. BACAAN KEDUA | Roma 5:6-11

Sebab tidak mudah seorang mau mati untuk orang yang benar -- tetapi untuk orang yang baik mungkin ada orang yang berani mati --. Akan tetapi Allah menunjukkan kasih-Nya kepada kita, oleh karena Kristus telah mati untuk kita, ketika kita masih berdosa.

Apalagi sekarang, saat kita telah dibenarkan oleh darah-Nya; pasti kita akan diselamatkan dari murka Allah. 4. INJIL | Matius 9:36-10:8

Sekali peristiwa, ketika Yesus melihat orang banyak yang mengikuti-Nya, tergeraklah hati-Nya oleh belas kasihan, karena mereka lelah dan terlantar seperti domba yang tidak bergembala. Maka kata Yesus kepada murid-murid-Nya, "Tuaian memang banyak, tetapi pekerja sedikit. Karena itu mintalah kepada tuan yang empunya tuaian, supaya Ia mengirinkan pekerja-pekerja ke tuaian itu."

Lalu Yesus memanggil kedua belas murid-Nya dan memberi kuasa untuk mengusir roh-roh jahat dan untuk melenyapkan segala penyakit dan segala kelemahan. Inilah nama kedua belas rasul itu: Pertama Simon yang disebut Petrus, dan Andreas saudaranya, Yakobus anak Zebedeus dan Yohanes saudaranya, Filipus dan Bartolomeus, Tomas dan Matius pemungut cukai, Yakobus anak Alfeus, dan Tadeus, Simon orang Zelot, dan Yudas Iskariot yang mengkhianati Yesus.

Yesus mengutus kedua belas murid itu dan berpesan kepada mereka, "Janganlah kamu menyimpang ke jalan bangsa lain atau masuk ke dalam kota orang Samaria, melainkan pergilah kepada domba-domba yang hilang dari umat Israel. Pergilah dan beritakanlah: Kerajaan Surga sudah dekat. Sembuhkanlah orang sakit; bangkitkanlah orang mati; tahirkanlah orang kusta; usirlah setan-setan. Kamu telah memperolehnya dengan cuma-cuma, karena itu berikanlah pula dengan cuma-cuma."

Nazarene Hitam di Gereja St. Philip Benizi



Black Nazarene adalah patung Yesus Kristus yang sedang memanggul salib, berukuran sebesar manusia asli dan berwarna gelap. Patung ini ditempatkan di Basilika Minor di Quiapo, Manila, Filipina, dan menjadi pusat devosi umat Katolik yang sangat besar. Patung ini terkenal karena dipercaya memiliki kekuatan penyembuhan ajaib serta memiliki makna budaya yang sangat penting.

Sejarah dan Makna

- **Asal-usul:** Patung ini dipahat oleh seorang seniman Meksiko yang tidak diketahui identitasnya pada abad ke-16 dan dibawa ke Manila oleh para misionaris Augustinian Recollect pada tahun 1606.

- **Warna "Hitam":** Menurut tradisi, patung ini memperoleh warna gelapnya setelah hangus akibat kebakaran di kapal galon yang mengangkutnya dari Meksiko ke Filipina.
- **Simbolisme:** Bagi jutaan umat, warna kulit yang gelap dan pose yang menggambarkan penderitaan—Yesus sedang berlutut di bawah beban salib—melambangkan perjuangan, ketangguhan, dan iman masyarakat biasa yang bukan berkulit putih.

Devosi dan Ritual

- **Traslación:** Puncak kegiatan devosi ini berlangsung setiap tahun pada tanggal 9 Januari. Jutaan umat dengan kaki telanjang berpartisipasi dalam prosesi berat yang memakan waktu 24 jam untuk mengemang kembali pemindahan patung tersebut ke Quiapo.
- **Ritual Sentuhan:** Umat rela menerjang kerumunan massa yang sangat padat demi menyentuh patung atau tali tebal yang menarik kereta pengangkutnya. Mereka percaya bahwa mengusap patung tersebut dengan handuk atau sapu tangan dapat menyembuhkan penyakit dan mendatangkan mukjizat ilahi.
- **Panata:** Devosi ini berakar kuat pada *panata* (kaul atau janji sebagai ungkapan syukur) atas doa yang terkabul dan kesulitan yang berhasil dilalui.

Struktur dan Perlindungan

Meskipun telah bertahan selama berabad-abad dari bencana alam, kebakaran saat kapal dan gereja hancur, serta pengeboman Manila selama Perang Dunia II, patung ini tetap utuh secara ajaib. Saat ini, patung tersebut ditempatkan di Basilika Minor dan Tempat Ziarah Nasional Jesus Nazareno (yang lebih dikenal sebagai Gereja Quiapo).

Komunitas St. Philip Benizi Bersatu dalam Misa Persatuan Hari Raya Pentakosta yang Penuh Sukacita

Komunitas yang beragam di Gereja Katolik St. Philip Benizi di Fullerton, California, berkumpul dalam kebersamaan yang penuh sukacita pada hari Minggu, 24 Mei 2026, untuk merayakan Hari Raya Pentakosta melalui Misa Persatuan istimewa yang dibawakan dalam tiga bahasa. Perayaan ini mempertemukan berbagai komunitas gereja—termasuk komunitas Indonesia, Filipina, dan Amerika Latin—dalam sebuah wujud nyata iman dan budaya yang indah dan saling berbagi.

Komunitas Katolik Indonesia Orange County (KKIOC) berperan besar dalam kesuksesan kuliner hari itu. Mereka mengelola stan makanan populer yang menjual hidangan favorit khas Indonesia, antara lain:

- Sate (sate ayam)
- Nasi Goreng
- Martabak

Komunitas lain juga membuka stan yang menyajikan hidangan khas Amerika, masakan Filipina seperti Chicken Adobo dan Pancit, serta sejumlah stan Meksiko yang menyajikan Pozole, Taco, dan Tamale.

Kisah-Kisah Utama

1. Allah Menggendong Kita Bagaiakan Burung Rajawali

Bacaan Pertama (Keluaran 19:2-6a): Allah memberikan pesan yang indah kepada Musa untuk disampaikan kepada bangsa Israel saat mereka berkemah di dekat sebuah gunung besar. Allah mengingatkan mereka bagaimana Ia telah menyelamatkan mereka dari bahaya dan berfirman bahwa Ia telah membawa mereka dengan aman "di atas sayap burung rajawali" untuk datang kepada-Nya. Allah menjanjikan bahwa mereka adalah milik kesayangan-Nya yang sangat istimewa.

2. Yesus Mengutus Para Pembantu-Nya

Injil (Matius 9:36-10:8): Yesus memandang kerumunan orang yang sangat banyak dan merasakan kasih serta belas kasihan yang mendalam bagi mereka, karena mereka tampak lelah, bingung, dan tersesat—bagaiakan domba tanpa gembala. Ia berkata kepada sahabat-sahabat-Nya (para murid) bahwa ada banyak pekerjaan yang harus dilakukan untuk menolong semua orang. Maka, Yesus memilih kedua belas Rasul-Nya, memberikan mereka kuasa istimewa untuk melayani, serta mengutus mereka

untuk memberitakan kabar baik, menyembuhkan orang sakit, dan membagikan kasih Allah secara cuma-cuma.

Tema Utama: "Sang Penolong yang Tak Terlihat"

1. Kamu adalah Harta Istimewa bagi Allah

Sama seperti saat Allah berfirman kepada umat-Nya di padang gurun, dan seperti seorang gembala yang mengasihi domba-dombanya, Allah mengasihimu secara pribadi. Kamu sangat berharga bagi-Nya, dan Dia senantiasa menjagamu serta siap menopangmu melewati masa-masa sulit.

2. Menjadi "Penolong" dalam Tim Yesus

Yesus tidak melakukan segalanya sendirian; Dia membentuk sebuah tim! Hari ini, Yesus juga mengundang kita untuk bergabung dalam tim penolong-Nya.

Cara anak-anak dapat melakukannya: Kamu tidak perlu pergi jauh untuk menjadi seorang rasul. Kamu bisa menjadi penolong dalam tim Yesus tepat di rumah atau di sekolah dengan cara berbagi mainan, membantu membereskan barang, menghibur teman yang sedang menangis, atau mendoakan orang yang sedang sakit.

3. "Memberi dengan Cuma-cuma": Kebaikan Hati

Yesus berkata kepada murid-murid-Nya, "Kamu telah menerimanya dengan cuma-cuma, karena itu berikanlah pula dengan cuma-cuma." Ini berarti Allah memberikan begitu banyak kasih dan sukacita kepada kita secara gratis, dan Dia ingin kita meneruskan kasih serta sukacita itu kepada orang lain tanpa mengharapkan imbalan apa pun.

The names of the twelve apostles are these: first, Simon called Peter, and his brother Andrew; James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John; Philip and Bartholomew, Thomas and Matthew the tax collector; James, the son of Alphaeus, and Thaddeus; Simon from Cana, and Judas Iscariot who betrayed him.

Jesus sent out these twelve after instructing them thus, "Do not go into pagan territory or enter a Samaritan town. Go rather to the lost sheep of the house of Israel. As you go, make this proclamation: 'The kingdom of heaven is at hand!' Cure the sick, raise the dead, cleanse lepers, drive out demons. Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give."

I believe in one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one Baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen.

Black Nazarene at St. Philip Benizi



The Black Nazarene is a life-sized, dark-colored statue of Jesus Christ carrying the cross. Enshrined in the Minor Basilica in Quiapo, Manila, Philippines, it is the focal point of a massive Catholic devotion. The statue is renowned for its believed miraculous healing powers and immense cultural significance.

History and Meaning

- **Origins:** The statue was carved by an unknown Mexican artisan in the 16th century and was brought to Manila by Augustinian Recollect missionaries in 1606.

- **The "Black" Color:** Tradition holds that the statue acquired its dark color after being charred by a fire on the galleon ship that transported it from Mexico to the Philippines.
- **Symbolism:** For millions of devotees, the dark complexion and the suffering pose—Jesus kneeling under the weight of the cross—symbolize the struggles, resilience, and faith of the common, non-white person.

The Devotion and Rituals

- **The Traslación:** The highlight of the devotion occurs annually on January 9. Millions of barefoot devotees participate in a grueling, 24-hour procession to reenact the transfer of the statue to Quiapo.
- **The Ritual of Touch:** Devotees brave massive, tightly packed crowds to touch the statue or the thick ropes pulling its carriage. They believe wiping the icon with towels or handkerchiefs can cure ailments and bring divine miracles.
- **Panata:** The devotion is deeply rooted in *panata* (a vow or promise of gratitude) for answered prayers and hardships overcome.

Structure and Protection

Despite surviving centuries of natural disasters, fires during ship and church destructions, and the bombings of Manila during World War II, the statue remains miraculously intact. Today, the image is housed in the [Minor Basilica and National Shrine of Jesus Nazareno](#) (commonly known as Quiapo Church).

Children's Liturgy of the Word

Parents: We invite you to spend some time discussing this weekend's readings with your children. By helping them understand God's word, you will help build a strong foundation of faith!

The Big Stories

1. God Carries Us Like Eagles (Exodus 19:2-6a)

The First Reading: God gives Moses a beautiful message for the people of Israel while they are camping near a big mountain. God reminds them how He rescued them from danger and says He carried them safely "on eagles' wings" to bring them to Him. God promises that they are His extra-special, treasured possession.

2. Jesus Sends Out His Helpers (Matthew 9:36-10:8)

The Gospel: Jesus looks out at a huge crowd of people and feels a lot of love and pity for them because they look tired, confused, and lost—like sheep without a shepherd. He tells His friends (the disciples) that there is a lot of work to do to help everyone. So, Jesus chooses His Twelve Apostles, gives them special helper-powers, and sends them out to preach, heal sick people, and share God's love for free.

The Main Theme: "The Invisible Helper"

1. You are God's Special Treasure

Just like God told the people in the desert, and just like a shepherd loves his sheep, God loves you personally. You are incredibly valuable to Him, and He is always watching over you, ready to carry you through tough times.

2. Being a "Helper" on Jesus' Team

Jesus didn't try to do everything alone; He built a team! Today, Jesus invites us to be on His helper team, too.

How kids can do this: You don't have to travel far away to be an apostle. You can be a helper on Jesus' team right at home or school by sharing your toys, helping clean up, comforting a friend who is crying, or saying a prayer for someone who is sick.

3. "Freely Give" Kindness

Jesus told His disciples, "Without cost you have received; without cost you are to give." This means God gives us so much love and joy for free, and He wants us to pass that love and joy along to others without expecting anything in return.

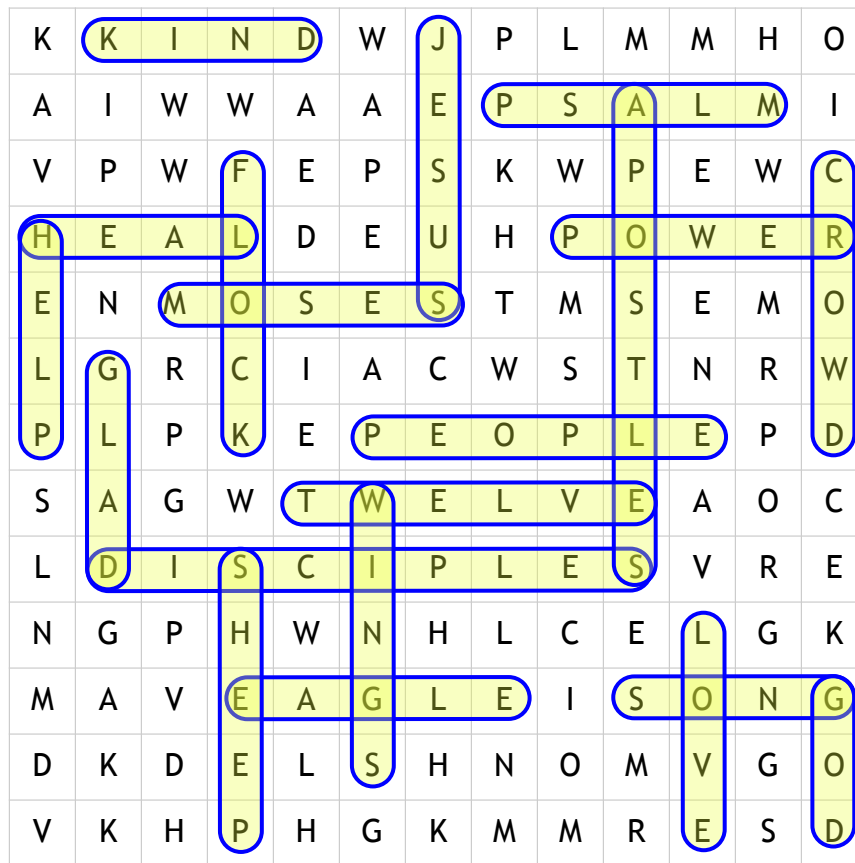
